SECTION 2. Pursuant to the Agreement, the City Council designates that the City Manager is recognized as the authorized officer for requesting, or receiving requests and for participation assistance relating to officials of other local governments.

SECTION 3. Upon adoption, the City Manager shall initially facilitate this Resolution through an agreement with the City of Marlette and report back to the City Council from time to time, cost savings and other information to implement Economic Vitality Programs.

SECTION 4. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this Resolution, it shall be effective upon being approved by a majority vote of the City Council of the City of Brown City, Sanilac County, Michigan by roll call vote at a regularly scheduled meeting.
