

IMPORTANT NOTICE

You are responsible for understanding and complying with the following. If you have any questions, please call City Hall at 346-2325.

Rubbish: Brown City will host Clean Up Day Monday, June 14th.
DO NOT put out rubbish earlier than June 10th. Please keep rubbish separate from your regular Monday garbage.

Monday, June 14th : All eligible items will be picked up. Metal cans CANNOT contain any liquid. Material must be bagged, tied in bundles, or placed in containers (NO 55 gallon drums). Carpet and small building materials must be rolled or bundled or containerized. Rolls/bundles must be less than 8' long.

******NOTE: refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc., that contain FREON require payment at City Hall of a \$15 fee PRIOR to June 10th***

The City WILL NOT PICK UP: tires, lead batteries, leaves, grass clippings, brush or tree branches, cable, fencing, wire, shingles, concrete, building materials such as lumber, or containers of liquid (cans, bottles, or buckets containing liquid paint, chemicals, tar, or other materials classified as Hazardous Household Waste). If you need to know how to dispose of any of this material, we have information at City Hall to help you.

Yard Waste: Knox Disposal is not obligated to pick up leaves, grass clippings, brush or tree branches. The Brown City Department of Public Works collects these on the second (2nd) and fourth (4th) Monday of each month (or the next day if Monday is a holiday). **Leaves and grass clippings must be placed in closed CLEAR plastic bags** (available at City Hall for 25¢ each). Brush and/or tree limbs must be cut into lengths of less than eight feet (8'), bundled, and securely tied. DPW is NOT required to pick up loose material.

Garbage: Knox Disposal picks up all trash and garbage from residences in the City of Brown City at least once a week. It is your responsibility to see that closed containers, bags, bundles and/or bins are placed at the street by 5:30 AM on the designated collection day (usually Monday). No trash or garbage should be put out for collection earlier than the day before scheduled pick up (24 hours maximum).
